OUR FOCUS...

As a team we are feeling God calling us to care for the widows and orphans of the world. Currently we have projects and partners in India, Kenya, Ukraine and the United States; and we are developing relationships in Ecuador.

Chinle, Arizona For many years we have sent teams to the Navajo reservation to teach Vacation Bible School to the children as well as to assist with various work projects at Trinity Presbyterian Church. In recent years our ministry to the people of Chinle has spread to the Chinle Nursing Home. Two teams go out each year – the summer team teaches VBS and completes work projects and the winter team takes Christmas gifts to the families and elderly gathered through our Shepherd Tree Project

Ecuador We are currently in the process of developing a relationship with the orphanages of For His Children in Quito and Latacunga. Our first team went to Ecuador in September 2007, on a vision trip to assess the needs as well as how Glenkirk can best serve the orphaned children of Ecuador.

India We are in the new stages of developing and sending teams through Glad Tidings/India Bible Literature. We are excited to be a part of delivering the Word of God in a tangible way to the unreached people groups in India.

Kenya Our partnership in Kenya is with the Presbyterian Church of East Africa Tumutumu Hospital in Karatina as well as the related entities such as the Mahiga Dispensary and Maternity Wing, the Kiaruhi Dispensary and Maternity Wing, the Tumutumu School for Hearing Impaired Children among others. Since 1999 we have sent teams each with different purposes and each team member with a different tasks including but not limited to HIV/AIDS education, work projects, leadership workshops for men and women, medical work, and Vacation Bible School.

Ukraine – Donetsk Christian University is a private, evangelical Christian university founded in 1991 by a Ukrainian mission society. DCU is dedicated to the training of pastors, missionaries, church planters, teachers, and other Christian workers with the dual purpose of serving the church and impacting the many needs in society. There is an opportunity to show the love of Christ through teaching English at the University during a summer mission trip.

Ukraine – Music Mission Kiev This ministry in Ukraine began and a choir and orchestra and has started a church, formed Christian Children's Clubs, Orphan Ministry and Widows Ministry. In 2006, a team from Glenkirk went to Ukraine to view and participate in the varying ministries of Music Mission Kiev and returned with a passion to further develop relationships with the widows and orphans of Ukraine.

DART – Disaster Assistance Relief Team enables our congregation to partner with the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and other service agencies to bear witness to the healing love of Christ through caring for communities affected by crises and catastrophic events.

Operation Christmas Child – Samaritan's Purse This project provides an opportunity for all ages in our congregation to participate in bringing joy and hope to children around the world.

Living Christmas Market is an alternative gift market held annually on the first Sunday in November. It is an opportunity to purchase gifts to help the poor and hungry around the world through Samaritan's Purse, Kids with a Mission, Angel Tree, and Shepherd Tree.

Women of Global Action (WOGA) Connecting women around the world in an effort to build relationships, to build capacity in women, to serve one another and to transform families, churches and communities for the glory of God.
