Week of January 16, 2010

1. Note the copy of the covenant posted on this site. Use this as you spend time with your group going over the ground rules.
2. Be sure and let your group know that they can get the Devo's and the discussion questions off the web. It might help if they download both and bring them to your group meeting. The Devo's will general include material that will be helpful in answering the discussion questions.
3. Please note there is more time during the "Share It" portion this week. The purpose of this is for your groups to get to know each other. Even if your group has been meeting for an extended period of time this would be a great exercise. Be sure and include any significant answers to prayers and goals for your future.
4. A good outline for a teaching on prayer might be:
  - a. Praying with the right motives
  - b. Having a right relationship with God
  - c. Having a real trust in the Lord
  - d. Dispensing of False Fronts
  - e. Pray in the morning; all night, and before each meal
  - f. Praying in the will of God
  - g. Prayer with two or more people
  - h. Pray for
    - i. Ourselves
    - ii. One another
    - iii. For ministries in the Body of Christ
    - iv. For the sick and distraught
    - v. For those ensnared by sin
  - i. As we prayer we need to:
    - i. Watch and pray always
    - ii. Pray, least we fall into temptation
    - iii. Pray for workers
    - iv. Pray for those in authority
    - v. Pray for your enemies

If you were to note the things you pray about how do they resemble or not resemble this outline? Why might this be so? What are the implications?
