How to Color Code

Color coding in your Bible can be helpful to see connections and in making observations. You have been supplied with colored pencils and a color code chart, which is also listed below. As you read the text (without consulting any outside material yet), color the passage as you see these connections. If you see an attribute of God listed, color it purple. If you see repeated words or phrases, color them yellow. If you notice salvation or gospel messages, color them red. You can do this on the text that is printed out in your study. Once you have done this, go back to your observations and add any connections you see.

Color Code Bible Study:

Purple: Attributes of God

Orange: Commands, Promises, & Wisdom

Yellow: Repeated/Key Words & Phrases

Brown: Covenants & Vows

Blue: Holy Spirit

Red: Salvation & Gospel

Black: Sinfulness & Depravity of man

Green: Faith & Spiritual Growth
