Sermon Series "Through Her Eyes" | January 3 - February 14

Like a mirror, each person was created by God to reflect God's image. Though this image has been damaged by sin, each person without exception still retains God's image, like a mirror that has been shattered. We continue to

reflect God as our creator, but often in broken and distorted ways. Through Jesus, God's image can be renewed and repaired in us to its original intent. The Bible's teaching about the image of God in people has profound implications for how we see and treat each other. We will look at how understanding God's image helps us address racism, cultural differences, the value of human life, relationships between men and women, and the impact of our words.
