- Biblical writers use antecedents to help the readers connect new ideas to God's activity in the past


Israel and the followers of Jesus experience salvation in the same way (Rom 10:5-13)




In order for people to believe the good news about Jesus they must first be told the gospel (Rom 10:14-15)




Hearing the gospel is not the same as accepting the gospel (Rom 10:16-21)
