The Fruit of the Spirit

Galatians 5:22-23

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But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Fruit of the Spirit

- "Fruit" not "Fruits"
- Three categories: how we relate to God, how we relate to others, how we relate to ourself

God	Others	Ourselves
Love	Patience	Faithfulness
Joy	Kindness	Gentleness
Peace	Goodness	Self-Control

Love: God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them. (1 John 4)

Joy: for me to live is Christ and to die is gain (Philippians 1)

Peace: For He Himself is our Peace (Ephesians 2)

Patience: Slow to anger, abounding in love (Psalm 103)

Kindness: In humility value others above yourselves (Philippians 2)

Goodness: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good, His love endures forever (Psalm 107)

Faithfulness: For the word of the Lord is right and true, He is faithful in all He does (Psalm 33)

Gentleness: He was pierced for our transgressions (Isaiah 53)

Self-Control: Run in such a way as to get the prize (1 Corinthians 9)
